Thank you for your interest in Silverwood's Foster Family Program! We have partnered with Idaho's Family and Children Services to provide children in foster care the opportunity to receive FREE admission to our park once a year! Family members of these children are also eligible for discounted tickets at our front gate with a completed application and a valid ID.

The well-being of the children in our community is a cause that is near and dear to our hearts. After many years of partnering with the Children's Village, a trauma-responsive safe haven for children that restores trust and hope for children and families who experience abuse, we learned more about the state of the fostering program. With the number of available foster homes decreasing, and the increase in the number of foster children over the past year due to socioeconomic factors, Idaho is also seeing an increase in the severity of the situations children are coming from. Now is the perfect time to implement a program such as this in efforts to lift the socioeconomic burden on local families.

Here at Silverwood, we want to do what we can to provide an environment for children to make happy, healthy, and lifelong memories with their families. The importance and impact that these foster families have on our youth are priceless. We are hoping that through this program, we can offer this opportunity to children that wouldn't be able to visit otherwise.
